

The glass features a special anti-drip coating. 4. Stainless steel ice tongs with zebu horn handle. Lorenzi Milano. 5. With its faceted surface, the Filippo ice bucket produced by Mario Luca Giusti in synthetic crystal seems to have been sculpted in ice. 6. Wine glasses with Liscia and Torsé finish from the Ve_nier collection by Mug by VG, which expresses the values of the great Italian glassmaking tradition in pieces with a contemporary style. 7.
