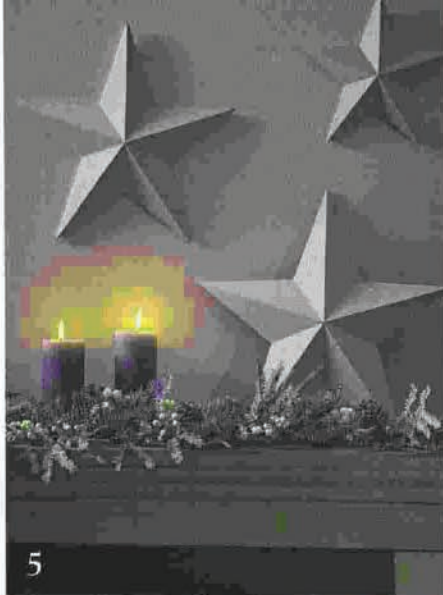




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4 To make a fragrant mini-wreath, wrap rosemary around a wire circle until the wire is covered, fasten with a twist tie. Next, thread a mini bauble onto a long piece of ribbon and tie it onto the wreath so that the ribbon covers the twist tie and the bauble hangs in the middle of the wreath. Use this ribbon to hang the wreath on the door, and for a final flourish tie a bow onto the top of the wreath with another ribbon in a matching colour to the bauble 5 Gesso stars, light grey, £60 for a set of three; faux winter-berry garland, £40; pillar candle in soft grey, £7.50, all Cox & Cox 6 Crushed-bead pear, £2.50, National Trust 7 Stag-and-mistletoe napkins, £45; crackers, £55, both Thornback & Peel 8 JSSR3 vintage DAB/FM digital radio, cream, £30, Sainsbury's 9 Snowhill wreath plate, £12; Croft Collection linen napkin, Loch Blue, £5, and all other items, John Lewis 12 Round marble-and-mango-wood serving board, £28.95, Decorator's Notebook 11 Star invitations, from £20 for a set of 10, Fraser & Parsley 12 Dolce Vita champagne flute, £12.50, [redacted] at Amara 13 Snowflake candleholder, matt white, £7, Houseology
