Mario Luca Giusti was born in Florence in a culturally rich and stimulant environment that from childhood had him steering towards a research on aesthetic and harmony, conditioning his love for the old and his fascination for the new. At the age of 16, he moved to Milan where he refined his taste for beauty and elegance at the literary tailoring of Germana Marucelli, a great designer, and also a promoter of Italian fashion; there he perfected his already refined taste for beauty and elegance. Upon his return to Florence, he successfully took over the footwear family business founded in 1865. It was later, in 2007, that the boutique under the same name, Mario Luca Giusti, was opened and soon won the Italian market and then the foreign market thanks to its large collection of items for the table that combine practicality and elegance, looking like crystal and glass, inspired in classic shapes, but revisited in contemporary materials such as acrylic (called, precisely, synthetic crystal) and melamine with which the dishes are made. An unmistakable style, something between fusion and pop, characterize the products by Mario Luca Giusti that embellish homes, pools, gardens and mega yachts. The collections are enhanced every year with new models and colors that range from white to black, from transparent in bright colors to opaque, creating an extraordinary and kaleidoscopic universe dedicated to tableware and beyond. Not surprisingly, the most important shops and most exclusive department stores in the world carry the collections of the Florentine boutique among
